I've made some new throw meters for my models.

F3K throwmeter is a small modification to the original throwmeter which m2models generously shared.

The F5J Flap throwmeter is a slightly bigger throwmeter of the same concept.

The F5J Aileron throwmeter is completely new, adjustable and allows to measure throws up to 30 mm in each direction if needed. The F5J Aileron Throwmeter is in 3 parts which are printed in one go and then the supports snap off and ends up pre assembled so no need to print separately.

I haven't fully tested them all, feel free to print and send me your feedback so I can improve them as necessary.


